- Ended gun shows at Orange County Fairgrounds. First bill he introduced. Working to make this a state-wide ban.
- Passed 8 bills, including.
  - Making reproductive coercion a form of domestic abuse: Forcing someone to get pregnant is a form of abuse.
  - Self-driving cars must be zero emissions by 2035.
  - 65 million in state pandemic funds to help 5000 businesses in his district.
  - Working to bring tax dollars back to his district. For example, infrared cameras for wildfire detection.
  - Sponsoring sustainability contest to design zero emission housing. Will be held at the OC Fairground
  - Next year:
    - a. Oil spill directly affected his district. Dangers of off-shore drilling. Working to end off-shore drilling.
    - b. Coastal economy worth \$44 billion/year. Oil that is extracted off-shore is a tiny percentage of oil extracted and of economy.
    - c. Formed Cybersecurity Committee in Senate.
    - d. Identity theft prevention.
  - Recall reform and referendum reform.
