What Is Project 2025?

- Phase I of Presidential transition project with four pillars:
 - I. Policy guide for next administration to overhaul the federal government
 - II. Personnel database who could serve in the next administration
 - III. Training for those candidates—Presidential Administration Academy
 - IV. Playbook of actions for first 180 days in office
- Led by The Heritage Foundation
- Advisory Board of 100+ conservative groups
- Chapter authors from Trump Administration and conservative groups

What Is Christian Nationalism (CN)?

What is it?

- Merges Christian and American identities, believes America is defined by Christianity
- Demands our laws should be based on Christian values

When is it a Christian Nationalist policy?

- A divine mission from God, freedom is defined by God, not man;
- Belief in natural law: universal rules from God that can't be superseded by government or judges
- Christians are so severely persecuted that it necessitates a federal response
- Anti-Christian bias by "Marxists and fascists"; investigate all forms of illegal discrimination

Why is it un-American?

- Distorts the Christian faith and America's constitutional democracy
- Often overlaps with, provides cover for, white supremacy and racial and gender subjugation

How much Christian Nationalism is in the US?

- 30% of Americans qualify as CN adherents or sympathizers
- 64% of white evangelical Protestants are CN
 - -- Yet 35% of Americans have never heard this term
- Red state residents significantly more likely to hold these beliefs
- Strongly liked to:
 - Republican party affiliation, and holding favorable views of Trump
 - Evangelical/born-again identity and frequent church attendance
- More likely to see political struggles through apocalyptic lens of revolution and to support political violence

Department of Education (ED)

Grievances

- Program bloat, failure to promote student achievement, executive overreach
- Institutions hostile to free expression, open academic inquiry, and American exceptionalism
- Woke "diversicrats"

What They Want

- Eliminate entire Department
- States to manage all policy and funding choices; with 'no strings' federak block-grants
- Shift student loans and grants to the private sector
- Rebalance, focus on workforce skills of Americans with no interest in four-year degree
- Offer diversity of education for traditional, faith-based institutions, technical and apprenticeships, career schools, military academies, life-long learning programs

Department of Education (ED) (cont'd)

Planned Policy Changes

- Department—eliminate; all programs move to other agencies including HHS, DoD, DOJ, State,
 Labor, Commerce, Agriculture, Bureau of Indian Education; terminate 4,400 workers
- Federal restrictions—lessen restrictions on charter schools, and school vouchers to all
- States—full education decision-making control, funding through 'no-strings' federal block grants
- DEI—eliminate all protections
- Unions—remove NEA's federal charter
- Parents—give more rights

Potential Impacts

- Huge state burden to build/maintain own departments of education, and coordinate across states
- Impact across states on education quality, pricing, availability, demand, breadth unknown
- Widening gap between well-funded colleges (wealthy) and struggling colleges (lower income)

Intelligence Community (IC)

Grievances—cabal of bureaucrats in DC

- DOS, DOD, and IC use risk aversion or political bureaucracy to slow President's foreign policy goals
- Officials insert political views to influence or control the analytic process
- Social engineering
- Triggers: Hunter's laptop, Russia collusion, Carter Page, 2020 election threat analysis, Covid 19 origins

What They Want

- Reign in bureaucracy: control all IC through ODNI, straight to President
- Whole-of-Government focus on dominant strategic threats: China and cyberspace mission
- Lose risk eversion, hesitancy, overly cautious groupthink, look forward not backward
- Install and empower the right personnel to manage, build, and effectively execute actions
- Punish any officials who "abuse the public trust"

Intelligence Community (IC) cont'd

Planned Policy Changes

- Move some CIA Directorates out of DC; end program's not consistent with President's mission
- Shift to private sector open source intel collection; IC focus on difficult/complex products
- Make DNI only IC Cabinet level position; confirm lead and authority over all 18 IC agencies
- Report to President only on his agenda; narrow PDB distribution; focus only on Presidential priorities
- Ensure loyalty, and eliminate woke culture and "social justice" advocacy; become risk acceptant
- Halt all new hiring to prevent "burrowing" in of outgoing political personnel; punish leadership at intransigent agencies
- President not constrained to use only the CIA for covert action

Potential Impacts

- Brutal impact on morale, cohesiveness, integration of IC products, loss of employees who can't move
- Erosion of intel collection capability, quality, and specialized reciprocal sharing
- Security risks with emphasis on private sector

Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)

Grievances—our long-term survival is at stake, our life expectancy has dropped

- Social engineering leaves us sicker, poorer and more divided
- Ban harmful identity politics
- Religious freedom, abortion and euthanasia are not health care, sacred rights of conscience, uphold bodily integrity
- Administrative state is harmful

What They Want

- End runaway entitlement
- Protect life, conscience and bodily integrity
- Empower patient choices and provider autonomy
- Promote stable and flourishing married families

Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) (cont'd)

Proposed Policy Changes

- Restrict Medicare choice of coverage and care
- Make Medicare Advantage the default enrollment option
 - Multi-source generic drugs off rebates from federal government
- Repeal Inflation Reduction Act
- Enforce work requirements to all federally funded programs
- Ban IVF, all abortion drugs, enforce Comstock Act, require in-person care to doctor,
- Promote pro-life research, abolish junk science and DEI office (NIH)

Potential Impacts

- Devastating life, medical and financial costs to families—especially women
- Heavy economic burden to states—homelessness, no health care, unplanned children, 'latchkey' children

Department of Homeland Security (DHS)

Grievances

- Bloated, bureaucratic, and expensive
- Lost sight of its mission priorities
- Suffered from Left's wokeness and weaponization against Americans they see as political opponents

What They Want

- Eliminate DHS. For now: reduce overhead, move functions to other Agencies, eliminate programs, privatize functions; "dismantle" everything else
- Prioritize border security and immigration law enforcement, including detention and deportation
- Punish countries that don't accept deportees
- Use military to stop migrants entering the country
- Exact revenge/retaliation on Biden Administration policies and personnel

Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (Cont'd)

Planned Policy Changes

- Eliminate DHS and unions. Now: move functions to other agencies, states, or privatize
- Huge funding increase: CBP (house, deport 'aliens'), USCG (ships, China threats, war)
- Eliminate/cap visa types: H-2A/B, ATD, trafficked humans, victims of mental-physical abuse
- Immediate raids on workforces and other "appropriate" investigations and operations
- Use military to build wall, stop mass migration events, and move migrants to legal ports of entry
- Take lead from DOS in Western Hemisphere on migration talks, punish non-acquiescent countries

Potential Impacts

- National trauma: military caused mass migrant deaths; workforce roundups; massive migrant detention camps; DACA deported; communities' fear and loss
- Burden on states to fund all flood, tornado, hurricane emergencies
- Burden on poor populations unable to pay for private flood insurance
- Cities identifying flood zones, putting moratorium on construction, capping and moving residents

Federal Trade Commission (FTC)

Grievances

- Burdensome regulatory compliance costs:
 - Favors big business
 - Undermines small businesses, can bar entrance for new competitors
- Large corporations use economic power to facilitate collusion between government and others who:
 - Require environmental, social and governance (ESG)
 - Engage in 'de-banking'

What They Want

- Use market mechanisms, not social responsibility—profit not ideology,
- Reduce regulatory compliance requirements

However, Conservative movement is divided between

- Keep anti-trust enforcement, and productivity and efficiency focus on economic-based consumer welfare approach
- Look at effects of business concentration on innovation, institutional resilience of our democracy and children's development

Federal Trade Commission (FTC) (cont'd

Planned Policy Changes

- Congress: investigate ESG practices as cover for anticompetitive activity, unfair trade practices
- FTC: examine platforms' advertising and contract-making with children as a deceptive or unfair trade practice
- FTC: institute unfair trade practices proceedings against entities that enter into contracts with children without parental consent

Potential Impacts, Scenarios, Consequences of change

- Redefine FTC's role in antitrust and enforcement
- Shrink FTC, move to states
- Enforce removal of all social value decisions in business, emphasis on children
- Major changes in regulation of Big Tech companies, and removing barriers to small companies
